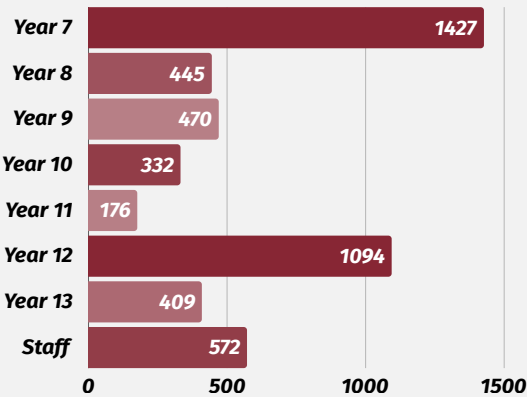

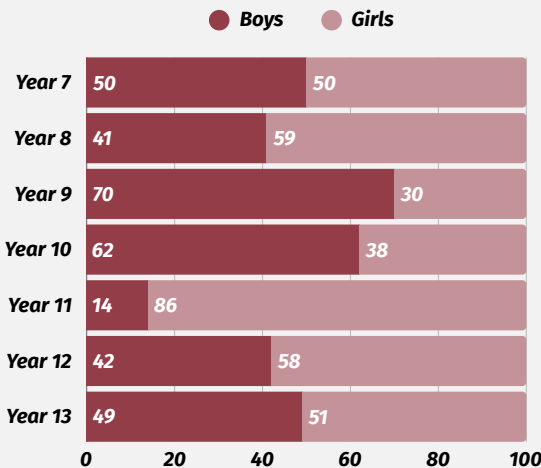

Loans by Year Group

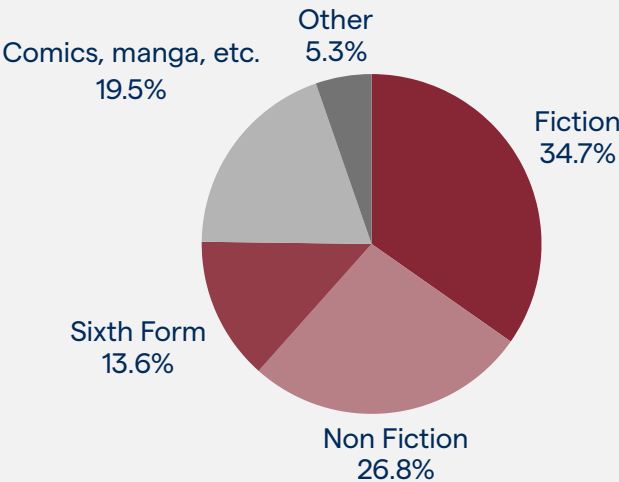


Loans by Gender

Events and Engagement



- **Carnegie Medal and Catherine Johnson:** we hosted the Dacorum Schools event to celebrate the awarding of this year's Carnegie Medal. Students from Berkhamsted, Ashlyns, John F Kennedy and Bushey Meads schools joined Kings Langley students in the library for a day of activities, including a talk from historical fiction author Catherine Johnson . Catherine also delivered an assembly to all of Year 7 and Year 8, and a workshop with a select group of KS3 students.
- **VE Day 80th Anniversary:** we collaborated with BBC Three Counties Radio and St Lauras Care Home on a letter exchange between our students and Joyce, a World War Two veteran.
- **Read With Pride:** we participated in the #ReadWithPride social media relay, celebrating LGBTQIA+ fiction for younger readers."
- **Craft Club:** in collaboration with Student Support, the library hosted and ran a weekly drop-in craft club, with an art therapy focus.

Other Projects and Events

- **Extended Project Qualification** - another excellent year, with 17 candidates completing their project. 94% of projects were graded C or above, with thirteen candidates achieving A* to B.
- **Reading Interventions** – using reading data and pastoral contexts, a small group of students were selected for flexible 1:1 interventions. These sessions are aimed at both improving their attitude towards reading, and building their confidence in their own ability to improve.
- **St Lauras** – we have continued our relationship with the care home, taking six groups of students to visit and read with residents this year.
- **Key Stage 3 Reading Lists** – after working closely with subject leads, these will be available from September for Geography, PRE, and History.
- **World Book Day** – we repeated the success of last year's event, with the sharing of stories read aloud by staff in all lessons across the day.
- **Pride Club** – continues to run weekly, with additional staff support and several keen new student members.
- **Community Library** – after a successful first trip last year, we made a second visit to the Kings Langley public library with a group of Year 7 students, as part of Activities Week.
