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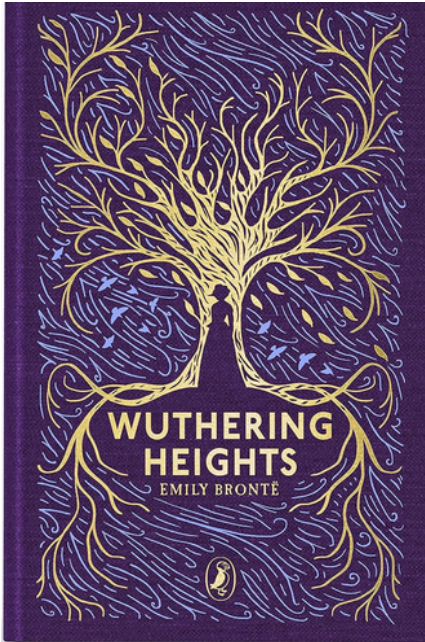

With an already-controversial new adaptation in the works, now's a great time to explore the bleak moors and twisted romance of Emily Bronte's classic novel.

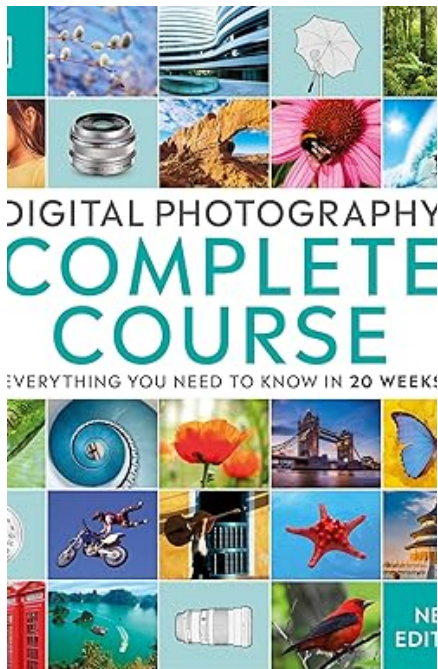
