16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is a £96 million fund, ringed fenced for schools, colleges and other 16-19 providers to support small group tuition for students in English, Mathematics and other courses where learning has been disrupted due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Kings Langley School was eligible to receive funding to support small group tuition. Sixth Form students not achieving at least a grade 4 at GCSE in maths or English are our priority group, but we are also able to offer support to students who achieved a grade 4 but wanted the opportunity to improve this to grade 5 or better. Tuition takes place in groups of no more than five students and includes those who are classified as disadvantaged students. Students are receiving a schedule of tutorial style lessons to support their Maths and English GCSE attainment and will be taking exams in November 2023 or Summer 2024.

This statement is in line with the Government guidance and we have published this statement to demonstrate how this additional funding will be utilised in the academic year 2023/24. This document may be updated to reflect any changes in ESFA guidance.
