

Exam Equipment

All exams for students in Years 7-9 and 12 are in classrooms, along with January exams for Year 10. The compulsory items on the school equipment list linked below will be required by students in their exams. Students should also ensure they have a water bottle so they can stay hydrated and focussed in their exams.

Trial exams for Year 11 and Year 13 students and end of year exams for Year 10 take place in the Sports Hall and Activity Studio. This gives students an opportunity to prepare for their GCSE or A level exams. Students should ensure they have all compulsory items on the school equipment list. Students should recognise they are required to write in black ink and should not use erasable pens, gel pens or highlighters as part of their answers. Students can complete diagrams and graphs in pencil. Exam board rules state that calculator lids are not allowed on exam desks and water bottles should be transparent, colourless and without writing or labels. These equipment rules will be in place for trial exams so students are prepared and aware ahead of their GCSE and A level exams.
