Free Microsoft 365 account

Your username and password will always be given to you by your computer science teacher. They will give you a temporary password which will ask you to change it when you first log in.

Username: [year of entry-surname-first initial@kls.herts.sch.uk] e.g 24bloggsj@kls.herts.sch.uk

Password: Do not share this with anyone except parents/carers.

Use a minimum of 8 letters and use one special character.



Online Homework



Maths watch – This is the digital platform we are using across the school for Maths homework.



Seneca - Is used by a variety of subjects across the school.



Bedrock – Is the homework platform for English.

All these platforms will be set as homework in MS Teams as your other subjects.



What is a single sign on (SSO)?

This is where you only need one username and password for many different platforms, rather than having to remember lots of different ones.






These platforms use SSO. You will need to be logged into Microsoft first for them to work if you are working at home.




























Follow the teacher instructions on the assignment. You may be asked to complete work on a document attached (as below) or to upload a new document with the work completed.

When you have completed the work. Click on the purple 'Turn in' button to submit it to your teacher for marking and feedback.






Digital Timetable on Teams

How to email a member of staff

Subject Line

Your subject line should be a short summary of your email (2-6 words maximum)

e.g Late work

Missing homework

Say hello

Just like you would in person, say 'hello' first

e.g Good morning, Mrs. Butt

Bonjour, Mr. Burgin

Why?

Tell the member of staff why you are emailing them. Include details.

e.g I am emailing because...

Can you please help me with...

End your Email

Close your email with a simple and polite goodbye.

e.g Thank you for your help.

Have a nice day.





Signposting for children and young people

Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP) helps any child or young person under the age of 18 who is being pressured, forced or tricked into taking part in sexual activity of any kind. This can be something that has taken place either online or in 'the real world', or both. The CEOP Safety Centre has clear information and advice on what can be reported to CEOP, the reporting process and what will happen if you do decide to make a report.

- Block
- Report



If you are experiencing online bullying or something else online has worried you please speak to an adult you trust, or you can talk to Childline at any time on 0800 1111 or via their website.

- Speak face to face explain why you are upset
- Calmly explain why you disagree but refrain from getting sucked into an online argument
- Ignore it?
- Tell someone if it has affected you negatively

MS Teams – Top tips

- 1. Students should visit the ICT office at break or lunchtime if they need their password reset.
- 2. They will write these in their planner.
- 3. Keep a record of your child's log in details at home.
- 4. You can log into MS teams as your child and view all assignments and homework set.
- 5. Email digest every Sunday sent to you with a summary of assignments for the week.
