

How will I know if my child is making progress?

- Year groups 7-10 have two points on the school calendar each year when students are engaged in formal assessments/examinations in all subjects. In Y11 students have three separate weeks of examinations plus their external GCSE exams
- Reports are emailed home twice a year and each year group has a Subject Consultation evening once a year
- Progress is continually monitored by Subject Teachers, Form Tutors, Pastoral Leaders, Learning Mentors and Senior Leaders
