What support will there be for my child's well-being?

- The Form tutor is responsible for every student in their form.
- Caring Pastoral Leaders, supported by Learning Mentors, are responsible for each year group.
- Pastoral staff and support staff have attended mental health first aid training.
- Students have Personal, Social and Health Education as a designated lesson in Y7-10 which includes the Pennsylvania University Resilience Programme in Y7.
- Head of Centre works within the Learning Support Department. She provides social skills groups and works with individual students.
- The school has a Designated Senior Person (DSP) who is responsible for safeguarding. He is assisted by six members of staff, one of which is the Individual Needs Officer.
- The school has counsellors who work within the school.
- The school liaises with outside agencies to support individual student's well-being.
- The school works with parents to support every student's mental health and well-being.
