



Careers in an Airport HOP Webinar - Thurs 1 Feb

The HOP webinar series returns for 2024 on Thursday 1st February (4:30) with a focus on **Careers in an Airport.** We will be joined by Alex Smith, Education Manager from Stansted Airport who will be able to talk about the wide range of roles and skills required to work in an Airport (excluding Air Traffic Control that will be covered in a future bespoke webinar, and Cabin Crew – which has been covered previously).

With four major international airports all on the Hertfordshire borders (Stansted, Luton, Heathrow and London City) there is huge demand for talented people to work in these vibrant, dynamic and exciting workplaces.

Would you like to earn a fee-free social research degree, whilst working in a paid government role?

Our Social Research Degree Level Apprenticeship allows them to do just that.

The apprenticeship programme offers a **first of its kind opportunity** to gain real experience working on some of the government's most impactful projects, while gaining a bespoke undergraduate degree in social research.

Apprentices will develop transferable and applied knowledge, skills and behaviours that will set them up for a **long career in modern social research**. Apprenticeships are available at **14 government departments across England**. Our apprentices will typically spend 4 days per week working in their government department, and 1 day studying online with the University of Kent.
