Student Finance

Student finance is now open for 2025 entry. If you haven't made your firm/insurance decisions yet, you can still apply by stating which university you think you're likely to attend. If you end up going elsewhere, it's really easy to change this detail in your portal before the start of term. You can start your application by going to gov.uk/apply-online-for-student-finance

Personal Statements 2026 Entry

Writing a strong personal statement can increase your chances of receiving offers from your preferred university choices. Admissions tutors use the statement to help them identify the applicants most suited for each course. You will need to demonstrate a genuine interest and passion for your chosen subject and skills that will benefit you while at university. The personal statement is a chance to make an impression and to stand out from the crowd.

For 2026 entry onwards, you will be answering 3 questions for your personal statement:

- Why do you want to study this course or subject?
- How have your qualifications and studies helped you to prepare for this course or subject?
- What else have you done to prepare outside of education, and why are these experiences useful?
