We use the following to help identify a student's SEND:

- Cognitive Ability Tests (Y7)
- Spelling & Reading results (Y7)
- KS2 SATs results/teacher assessments
- Information from previous school
- Previous tests or assessments
- Parents' concerns
- Teachers' concerns
- Assessments from external agencies
- Observations from staff
- In-school assessments
- Attendance data

- Speech, language and communication needs SLCN
- Visual Impairment
- Hearing Impairment
